DEKALB COUNTY SCHOOLS BULLYING/HARASSMENT PROCEDURE FOR SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS

- 1. Forms for reporting bullying/harassment may be obtained in the office of the principal, counselor, or nurse (and later on our website).
- 2. The school administration, in conjunction with additional system personnel (if necessary), will investigate the alleged incident to verify those involved and the particulars of the event.
- 3. Neither victim nor witnesses should be promised confidentiality at the onset of an investigation. It cannot be predicted what will be discovered or if a hearing may result from the ultimate outcome of the investigation. Efforts should be made to increase the confidence and trust of the victim and any witnesses. They will be informed that any information discussed and recorded will be confided to "need to know" status.
- 4. Parents of both the student aggrieved and the offender will be contacted by mail and by phone call.
- 5. School administrators (and appropriate system personnel if needed) will apply both consequences and/or remedial actions based on DeKalb County Board of Education policies. The consequences may/may not include the services of Mr. Thomas Whitten and DeKalb Youth Services.
- 6. A written log of the incident will be maintained, disciplinary action(s) taken, statements made, and any evidence maintained while any criminal investigation is ongoing.
- 7. Separate parent conferences with parents of both the victim and offender(s) will be scheduled within a two (2) week period to discuss the event and action to be taken. After four (4) weeks, the victim and his/her parent(s) will have a follow up conference scheduled to ensure bullying/harassment has ceased.
- 8. Any criminal behavior shall be reported to the appropriate law enforcement agency.
